Both owner and the rider/exhibitor need NOT be a member of CHAPS (UK) nor must be the horse or pony be registered with CHAPS (UK) to compete. However, in order to qualify both owner and rider / exhibitor need to be a current showing member and have a valid qualifier card. Members to apply to CHAPS (UK) for appropriate qualifier card.

The CHAPS (UK) Championship show will be held on 15th-17th August 2024

HORSE of the YEAR SHOW QUALIFIER CLASSES

Conf Judge: Mrs W King; Ride Judge: Mrs C Richardson

This competition is open to mares, geldings and CHAPS (UK) graded stallions **excluding in Section (A)**. Ponies/horses must be four years old or over, to be registered in, and complying with the showing requirements of, the main body of the stud books of the Coloured Horse and Pony Society CHAPS (UK) or the Traditional Gypsy Cob Association (TGCA). Stallions are required to wear stallion discs in order to compete.

All Riders and owners must be Members of the Coloured Horse and Pony Society, The Showing Register or the Traditional Gypsy Cob Association.

Exhibitors are required by DEFRA to carry with them Official Identity Documents for all horses/ponies when competing or travelling. Competitors are reminded that it is a DEFRA requirement that the Official Identity Documents must be in the same name of the legal owner within 30 days of ownership. This must be registered with the breed society, relevant studbook or ID issuing agency, dependant on breed/type of animal. Spot check may be carried out at qualifying shows and by breed societies.

29. **(A) Junior Ridden Native/Cob/Traditional Ponies** (up to and including 148cms) **and Non-Native Ponies** (up to and incl 153cms).

30. **(B) Coloured Ridden Non-native Pony**. Up to and including 153cms. Sponsored by CHAPS(UK)/Appleton Grange Stud.
31. **(C) Coloured Ridden Non-native Horse**. Exc 153cms. Sponsored by CHAPS(UK)/Burghwallis Stud.
32. **(D) Coloured Ridden Native, Cob, Traditional Pony**. Up to and including 148cms. Sponsored by CHAPS(UK)/The White Crow.
33. **(E) Coloured Ridden Native, Cob, Traditional Horse**. Exc 148cms. Sponsored by CHAPS(UK)/EJL Stud and Livery.
Championship: 1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 29-33 to compete.
Championship will take place in the Evening Performance.
Champion and reserve will compete for Supreme Ridden Championship.

Riders in Section (A) must not have attained their 18th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Please note that at Horse of the Year Show, ponies must not compete in both the Junior Coloured Ridden Pony of the Year and the Coloured Ridden Pony of the Year classes. The pony will compete in the class in which it qualifies first during the season. Riders and ponies may compete in both Section (A), Section (B) and Section (D) at HOYS qualifiers. Once a pony has qualified in either Section (A), Section (B) or Section (D), it will no longer be eligible to compete in the section in which it has not qualified.

For height restricted exhibits a valid JMB number must be lodged with the respective society within 28 days of qualification or before the Final, whichever is sooner.

These classes will be run in accordance with the general rules as set out in the Horse of the Year Show rulebook, a copy of which can be downloaded from www.hoys.co.uk.

This is a Horse of the Year Show Qualifier, all data given upon entry of this class is provided to Grandstand Media Limited and stored on the Grandstand Entries System. For full policy details please visit www.grandstandentries.com.

Marks will be awarded in the following way:

Ride/Performance	50 Marks Maximum
Conformation, Movement & Quality	50 Marks Maximum

In the case of equality, the horse with the highest Ride/Performance mark will be deemed the winner. If there is still equality at this point, then the judges' decision will be final.

This class is a qualifying class for Horse of the Year Show, NEC, Birmingham, 9th-13th October 2024. Qualification will not pass below 5th place. Qualification will be verified by the Horse of the Year Show office.
